



Service 47 "The Cuckmere Valley Ramblerbus" Route description:

Saturdays and Sundays & Bank Holiday Mondays during British Summer Time - March to October (BST).

Berwick Railway Station to Berwick Railway Station (circular - operates anti-clockwise)

Via Drusillas, Alfriston, Chyngton, Seaford, Exceat, Seven Sisters Country Park, Litlington, Lullington and Wilmington.

Berwick Station South Car Park, C39, Pound Lane, Berwick Crossroads, A27, Drusillas Roundabout, Alfriston Road, Alfriston Square, High and Over, Hillside Avenue, Walmer Road, Chyngton Gardens, A259 Sutton Avenue, Steyne Road, Seaford Pelham Road Morrisons, Dane Road, A259 Clinton Place, Sutton Park Road, Sutton Road, Eastbourne Road, Exceat, Litlington Road, The Street, Litlington, Lullington Corner, Chapel Hill, Wilmington Crossroads, A27 Lewes Road, Drusillas Roundabout, Berwick Crossroads, Pound Lane, C39 Station Road, Berwick Station South Car Park (reverse). Bus Waits in Station Car Park.

This service travels past, or near, the following attractions:

Berwick Church Bloomsbury Murals, English Wine Centre, Drusillas Park, Alfriston Medieval Village & Clergy House (NT), Rathfinny Wine Estate, High & Over and the Litlington White Horse, Seaford Martello Museum, Seaford Head and Seafront, The Cuckmere River, Seven Sisters Country Park, Friston Forest, The South Downs Way, Litlington Village, The Long Man of Wilmington, Wilmington Village.

In addition, the bus passes numerous Tea Gardens, Cafes and Public houses on-route at Berwick Station, Berwick Village, Alfriston, Seaford, Exceat, Seven Sisters, Litlington Village and Wilmington.
